## About us:

- > BC Interior Community Foundation (BCICF) is a non-profit organization that was founded in 1984 to provide lasting support for charitable activities and local priorities.
- > We serve as a bridge between donors and charities in the Thompson, Nicola and South Cariboo region.
- > 1984 The Community Fund was the first fund established; the early donors included Weyerhaeuser Foundation and Dr. Stewart Burris.
- > By the summer of 1985, our endowment had grown to \$15,000.
- > 1986 The first grants were distributed (\$100 each) to the Kamloops Child Development Centre, the Kamloops Club for the Blind, the Kamloops Community Music School and the Elizabeth Fry Society.
- > 1991 Our endowed was at \$40,827, and grants distributed was \$2,650
- > 1993 The first large gift, \$131,000 from the City of Kamloops, and established the Centennial Legacy Funds A and B.
- > 2001 Total amount of discretionary grants made annually exceeds \$20,000.

Supporting students is a priority for our fundholders. BCICF holds over 75 endowed student award funds. Pictured here is scholarship recipient M. McGillivray.

- > 2006 Kamloops Foundation leadership is instrumental in creating a joint fundraising campaign called "Creating Tomorrow" to benefit the Kamloops Art Gallery, the Kamloops Symphony and Western Canada Theatre.
- > 2010 We opened an office and hired our first staff member, no longer a completely volunteerrun organization.
- > 2013 We change our name to BC Interior Community Foundation to better represent the region that we serve.
- > 2019 Over \$370,000 is given back to our communities in grants and scholarships.
- > Today We hold approximately 210 funds, that were started by local organizations, individuals and families, amounting to \$11 million in assets.
